Code of Conducts

Coach/Manager

- Coach/Manager are to recognize that they represent the Province of Ontario as well as Cricket Council of Ontario and are to conduct them at all times in a manner which will not reflect negatively on CCO or be disruptive to those around them.
- The team coach & the manager have the full responsibility of the athletes during the entire travel period unless otherwise decided by the CCO.
- Smoking in the presence of team members is not permitted.
- Coaches shall not consume alcohol at any time while they are performing their official duties as a member of team Ontario.
- The use, consumption and /or possession of drugs are forbidden unless prescribed by a medical doctor
- The use of foul language and or offensive behavior will not be tolerated
- Failure to abide by these guidelines may result in disciplinary action including, but not limited to, reprimand, being sent home at your own expense and or suspension from CCO in addition to any sanctions or penalties imposed by law or other agents
- Serving as a role model to his/her players
- Abiding by all the rules of the CCO
- Respect for officials
